**Day 1 October 12, Friday: Depart USA**

Depart Sioux Falls and St. Paul-Minneapolis International Airport on Delta Air Lines Alliance for the overnight flight to Warsaw, via Paris CDG. Dinner, breakfast and beverages will be served in-flight. (D,B)

**Day 2 October 13, Saturday: Welcome to Warsaw**

Arrive at Warsaw International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way tour manager will meet us as we exit Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way to Warsaw, the capital of Poland. Check-in at hotel. **Celebrate Mass at Santa Barbara Church or All Saints Church.** Return to the hotel for dinner.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Warsaw. (D)

**Day 3 October 14, Sunday: Niepokalanow | Czestochowa**

Buffet breakfast at hotel. This morning we will have an orientation tour of Warsaw. Drive along the royal route through the glamorous Nowy-wiat shopping street mostly rebuilt after WWII. Then we leave Warsaw to visit Niepokalanow, where St. Maximilian Kolbe initiated the "City of the Immaculata" dedicated to the movement of Marian Consecration. Independent lunch. After lunch, continue to Czestochowa. Upon arrival, **celebrate Mass at Jasna Gora**, the Paulite Monastery and largest Marian shrine in Poland, home to the miraculous "Black Madonna." After Mass enjoy a guided visit of the Monastery with its Chapel of the Virgin, where the sacred icon is kept for veneration by the faithful. We will also visit the beautiful Basilica of the Holy Cross and the Nativity of Mary with its magnificent Baroque altar depicting the Assumption of Our Lady into Heaven. Tour the Monastery's Museum housing offerings from the prisoners of the Nazi and Communist concentration camps. The Treasury houses many votive offerings left by pilgrims, including those given to the Monastery by Pope St. John Paul II. Check-in at hotel in Czestochowa. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Czestochowa. (B,D)

**Day 4 October 15, Monday: Czestochowa | Zakopane**

Buffet breakfast at hotel. This morning, **return to the Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa to celebrate Mass.** After Mass, we will depart Czestochowa for Zakopane, nestled in the Tatra Mountains. The Tatras are the highest part of the Carpathian mountain range. St. John Paul II spent a lot of his time in these mountains as a hiker, skier, traveller, priest with youth trips, and returned to the area he loved several times as Pope. Independent lunch upon arrival. In the afternoon, we will visit Villa Atma, a typical example of traditional wooden architecture. It was the house of famous 20th Century Polish composer and pianist, Karol Szymanowski. Born in today's Ukraine, Szymanowski eventually settled in Zakopane where he was inspired to create some of his best works. The house was opened as a museum in 1976 and the interior recreates the spirit of the place as it was in the composer's times. Enjoy free time at Krupowki Street, a pedestrian area lined with coffee shops and souvenir shops. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Zakopane. (B,D)

**Day 5 October 16, Tuesday: Zakopane | Krakow**

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. This morning, we will visit the Jewish Quarin Krzeptowki, which was built by the mountaineers in gratitude to the Virgin Mary for saving the life of the Pope from an assassination attempt. The oldest part of the complex is the Chapel of the Immaculate Heart of Virgin Mary, built in 1951, with the statue of Our Lady of Fatima located inside. Perhaps in your free time you might take the scenic gondolas to the top of Mt. Gubalowka for a bird's eye view of the city and Tatras'. Independent lunch. In the afternoon, we will continue to Krakow. **We will mark our arrival in Krakow with the celebration of Mass on the 40th Anniversary Pope St. John Paul II's Pontificate.** After Mass, check-in at hotel the remainder of the afternoon is at leisure\*.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Krakow. (B,D)

\*Possible meeting with Cardinal Stanislaw Dziwisz at his residence.



**Day 6 October 17, Wednesday: Highlights of Krakow | Wieliczka Salt Mines**

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast, our local guide will take us to visit St. Stanislaus Kostka Church where, as a seminarian, Karol Woytola attended Mass every day and where Fr. Wojtyla offered his second Mass. **Celebrate Mass at St. Stanislaus.** After Mass continue to Wawel Cathedral, the burial place of Polish kings. St. John Paul II offered his first Mass here in the Crypt of St. Leonard. We will visit Kanoniczna Street where he resided while living in Krakow. Visit the Franciscan Church where Fr. Wojtyla loved to come and spend quiet time in prayer. Pass the Archbishop's Palace to see where Fr. Wojtyla attended the seminary, was ordained and lived as a Cardinal. In the Old Town, we will visit the Basilica of St. Mary (Mariacki). See the noon opening of Europe's largest Gothic wooden altar, built by sculptor Wit Stows in the 15th century from gilded linden wood. Continue to Market Square, one of the largest medieval market squares in Europe. Independent lunch in the Old Town. In the afternoon, we will tour Wieliczka, one of the oldest salt mines in Europe. Wieliczka is a unique place where many generations of Polish miners have created a world of underground salt lakes with a rich interior of decorated chapels including the famous Blessed Kings Chapel, plus other galleries and workings made of salt. The Wieliczka salt mines are a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Krakow. (B,D)

**Day 7 October 18, Thursday: Auschwitz | Divine Mercy Shrine | John Paul II Center**

Buffet breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, depart or Auschwitz. Upon arrival we will have a guided tour of the Concentration Camp and Museum, including "Auschwitz II" at Birkenau. Auschwitz is known as a Nazi death camp, and also the site of martyrdom for St. Maximilian Kolbe, who willingly offered to die in a stranger's place as an act of Christian charity. Edith Stein (St. Theresa Benedicta) died here as she stood up for the lives of others. Time will be given for reflection and prayer. Independent lunch. Return to Krakow to visit the Divine Mercy Shrine, dedicated by St. John Paul II during his last visit to Poland in 2002. We will tour the divine Mercy complex, including the original burial site of St. Faustina. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine.** Continue to the John Paul II Center. See the octagonal lower church dedicated to John Paul II, known as the Church of the Relics (Kosciol Relikwi), decorated with vividly-colored images depicting events from the pontificate of Pope John Paul II and his visits to the world's most famous Marian sanctuaries. The centerpiece of the shrine is a simple marble altar in the middle that contains a vial with the relic of the blood of St. John Paul II displayed in a glass case.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Krakow. (B,D)

**Day 8 October 19, Friday: Wadowice | Warsaw**

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. This morning, we will depart Krakow for a visit to Wadowice, hometown of St. John Paul II. Visit his childhood home, which is now a museum, and the Church of the Presentation of the Virgin Mary where he was baptized. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Presentation.** Independent lunch. After lunch, we continue to Warsaw for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Warsaw. (B,D)

**Day 9 October 20, Saturday: Return to the USA**

Early morning, we will be transferred to Warsaw Airport for our return flight to the USA.



**PAYMENT:** Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or debit/credit card. A discount of \$100.00 per person will apply for payments made entirely by personal check, money order or certified bank check. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or debit/credit card.

**CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS:** From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

**LATE RESERVATIONS:** A \$25.00 late reservation fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on brochure.

**TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:** All participants must have a valid passport. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents, including passport.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** Round trip on Delta/Air France Alliance from Sioux Falls Regional Airport. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

**AIRLINE SEATING:** Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the land only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

**LAND ONLY PASSENGERS:** Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. **All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently.** A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (**\$2,300.00 per person sharing a twin room.**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

**DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES:** Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

**TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE:** Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

**ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS:** Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Matrimonial (full) bedded rooms are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available but we discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or matrimonial (full) bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an **additional charge of \$550.00**. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

**MEALS:** Buffet breakfast and dinner daily including a farewell dinner with wine and entertainment at restaurant in Krakow.

**GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES:** Gratuities are not included in your tour package. For good work, we recommend 4,00 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; 2,00 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; 1,50 Euro per person for a local guide when applicable. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave 1,00 Euro per person for your waiter following dinner at the hotel and 1,00 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
